and I shall make the rivers as outlying territories and the ponds shall I cause to dry up;
and I shall guide the blind in a manner they do not know, I shall lead them through paths they hath not known;
I shall turn the darkness before their faces into Light, and straighten the crooked places.

These words shall I fulfil for them and not forsake them.
They shall be turned back and they shall be greatly ashamed, those who trust in an image, who saith unto an image, Thou art our God!
Hear ye deaf, and look around ye blind, that ye may see.

Who is blind except My Servant, or as deaf as My Messenger whom I shall send? Who is blind as the Muslim and as blind as the Servant of the LORD?
Thou seest much without observation; the ears are open, but He doth not hear.
The LORD is zealous for the sake of His fidelity in magnifying the Torah!
But it is a people robbed and spoiled, all of them trapped in crevices, and in enclosed houses they are hidden;
they are for a prey and without deliverance; for plunder and none saith, Return!
Who from amongst thee shall give ear to this, who shall listen and hearken unto the outcome?
Who gave up Jacob for plunder and Israel to the robbers?
Was it not the LORD against Whom we hath sinned?
For they would not walk in His Paths nor be observant of His Torah.
Therefore shall He pour out upon Him the fury of His anger and the forces of warfare;
and it hath emblazoned Him all around, but He knew it not;
and it hath burned Him, but He did not take it to heart...
