Joseph leaves Egypt to bury Jacob in 2255 AE/1901 BC (Gen. 50:1-13). Sesostri III became Pharaoh in 2279 AE/1877 BC, the Pharaoh who did not know Joseph (Ex. 1:8-14). This began the 430 year affliction of the Hebrews (Ex. 12:40; Gal. 3:17). Later, the Hyskos overran Egypt and their affliction increased (2436-2606 AE/1720-1550 BC). With Joseph's death in 2309 AE/1847 BC the 400 year affliction began (Gen. 15:13).
