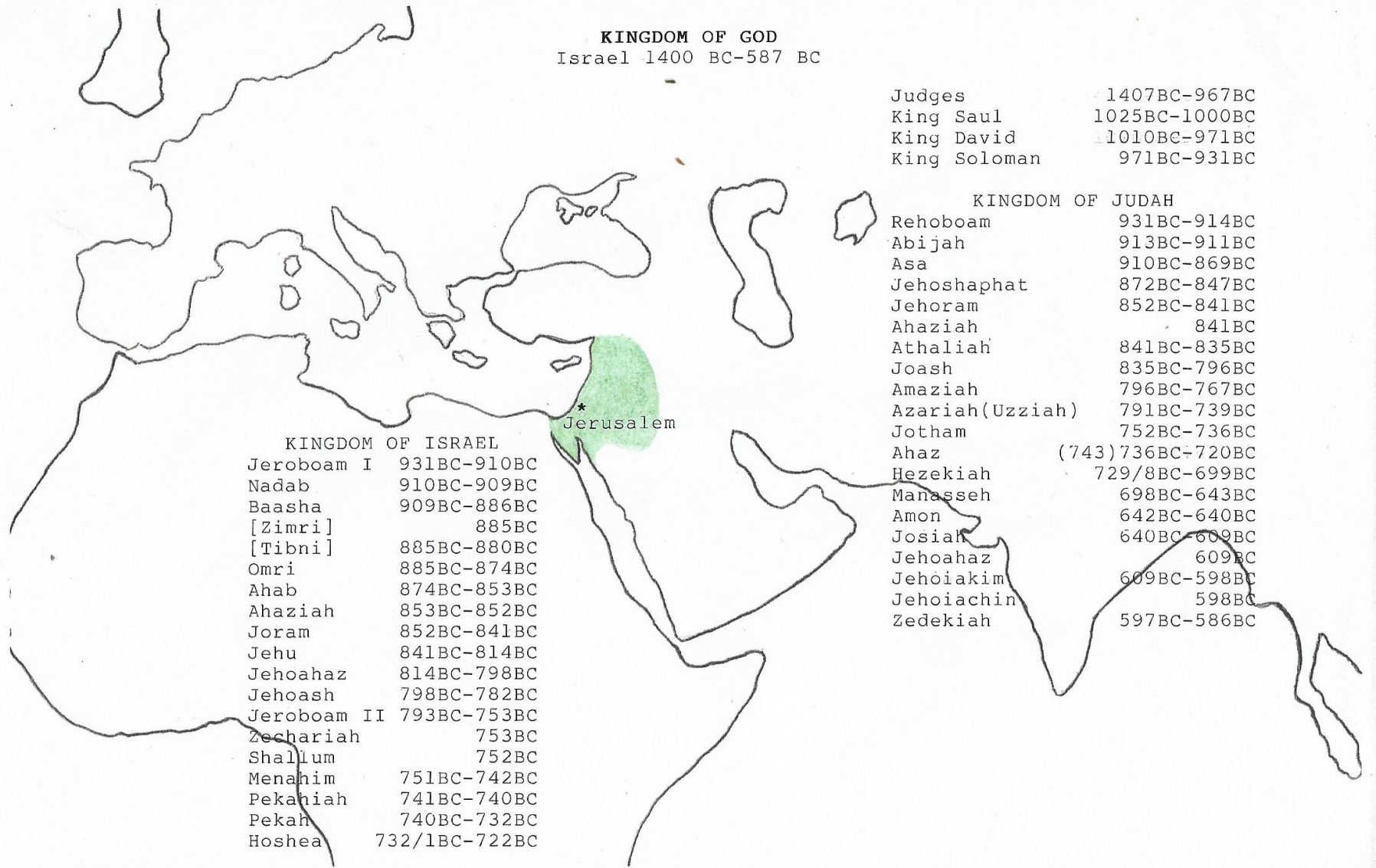

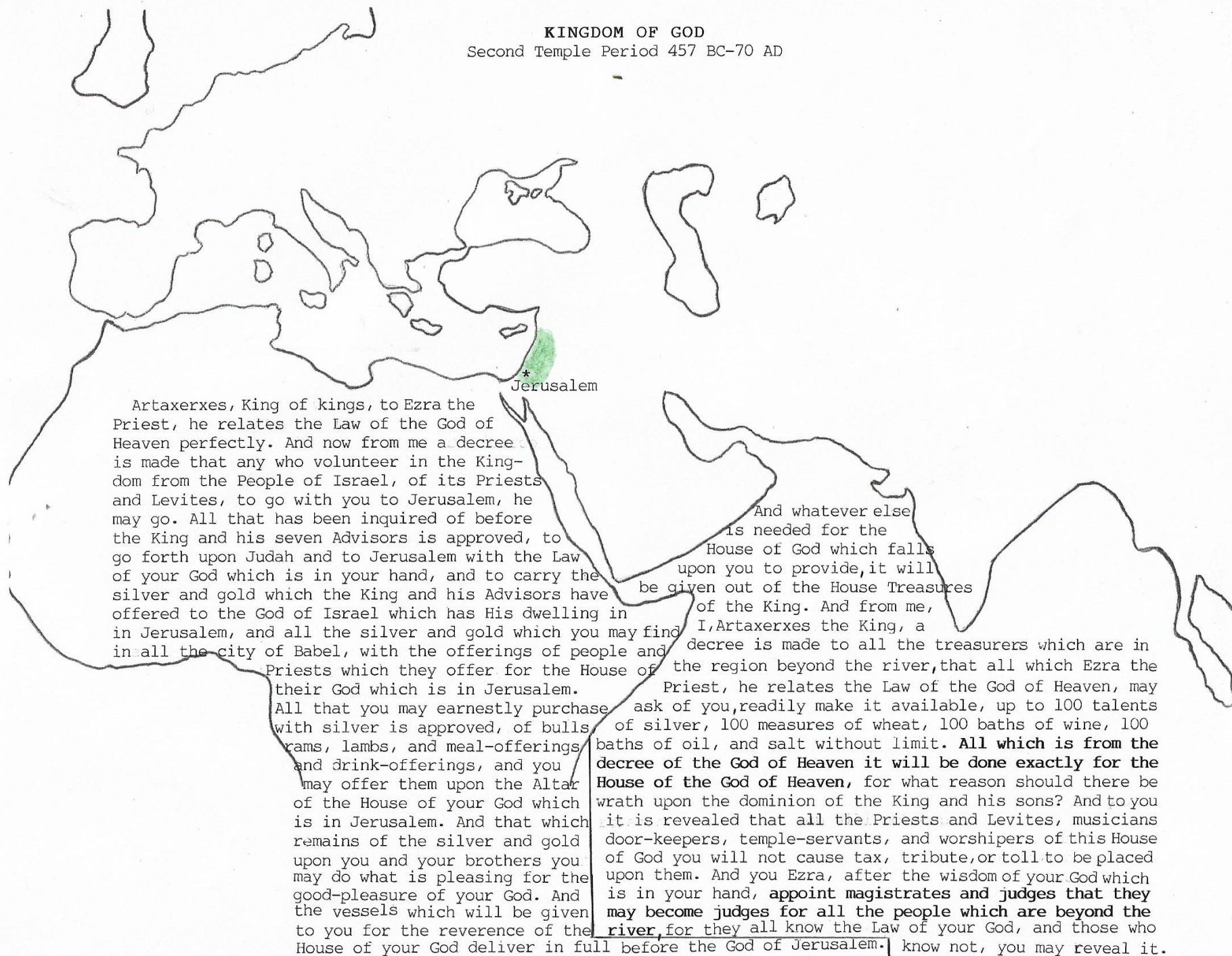

Artaxerxes, King of kings, to Ezra the Priest, he relates the Law of the God of Heaven perfectly. And now from me a decree is made that any who volunteer in the Kingdom from the People of Israel, of its Priests and Levites, to go with you to Jerusalem, he may go. All that has been inquired of before the King and his seven Advisors is approved, to go forth upon Judah and to Jerusalem with the Law of your God which is in your hand, and to carry the silver and gold which the King and his Advisors have offered to the God of Israel which has His dwelling in Jerusalem, and all the silver and gold which you may find in all the city of Babel, with the offerings of people and Priests which they offer for the House of their God which is in Jerusalem. All that you may earnestly purchase with silver is approved, of bulls, rams, lambs, and meal-offerings, and drink-offerings, and you may offer them upon the Altar of the House of your God which is in Jerusalem. And that which remains of the silver and gold upon you and your brothers you may do what is pleasing for the good-pleasure of your God. And the vessels which will be given to you for the reverence of the House of your God deliver in full before the God of Jerusalem.

And whatever else is needed for the House of God which falls upon you to provide, it will be given out of the House Treasures of the King. And from me, I, Artaxerxes the King, a decree is made to all the treasurers which are in the region beyond the river, that all which Ezra the Priest, he relates the Law of the God of Heaven, may ask of you, readily make it available, up to 100 talents of silver, 100 measures of wheat, 100 baths of wine, 100 baths of oil, and salt without limit. **All which is from the decree of the God of Heaven it will be done exactly for the House of the God of Heaven,** for what reason should there be wrath upon the dominion of the King and his sons? And to you it is revealed that all the Priests and Levites, musicians, door-keepers, temple-servants, and worshipers of this House of God you will not cause tax, tribute, or toll to be placed upon them. And you Ezra, after the wisdom of your God which is in your hand, **appoint magistrates and judges that they may become judges for all the people which are beyond the river, for they all know the Law of your God,** and those who know not, you may reveal it.
