

Third Ascent

**Blessed is the reader, and those who heareth the words of the prophecy,
and keepeth that which hath been written therein; for the time is near.**

John to the seven Assemblies who are in Asia:

**Grace be unto you and peace from Him Who is and Him Who hath been and Him Who is coming,

Whoever hath an ear, let them hear what the Spirit saith unto the Assemblies.

Whosoever overcometh, I shall give to them the hidden manna;
and will gift unto them a white stone, and upon the stone a new name hath been written,
which no one hath known, unless they receiveth it.

II.

**And around the Throne, *there were twenty-four thrones;*
and upon the thrones *there were twenty-four Elders sitting, clothed in white raiment;*
and upon Their heads, *there were crowns of gold.***

And One of the Elders saith unto me,

Do not Weep.

**Behold, the Lion of the tribe of Judah, the Root of David, prevaieth to open the Book,
and to break the seven Seals thereof.**

And as He was opening the third Seal,

I heard the third beast say, Come and see.

And I beheld, and behold, a black horse,

and the One sitting upon it was holding a scale of balances in His hand.

of the tribe of Asher twelve thousand,

of the tribe of Nephthali twelve thousand,

of the tribe of Manasseh twelve thousand,

of the tribe of Simeon twelve thousand,

of the tribe of Levi twelve thousand,

of the tribe of Issachar twelve thousand,

of the tribe of Zebulun twelve thousand,

of the tribe of Joseph twelve thousand,

of the tribe of Benjamin twelve thousand were sealed.

And the third Angel blew the Trumpet,

and a great star fell from heaven, burning like a lamp.

And it fell upon a third of the rivers, and upon the springs of waters.

And the name of the star is called Wormwood.

And a third of the waters became wormwood,

and many of Adam died from the waters,

because they were made bitter.

**And the Angel Whom I saw standing upon the sea and upon the earth lifted up His right hand unto heaven,
and swore, By Him Who liveth from age to age, Who created heaven and that which is within it,
and the earth and that which is within it, and the sea and that which is within it,**

There is no more time!

**But in the days of the voice of the seventh Angel,
as He shall begin to sound His Trumpet the Mystery of God shall be concluded,
for He will have declared the Prophets unto His servants.**

And I will provide My two Witnesses,
and They shall prophesy for a thousand two hundred and sixty days, wearing sackcloth.

These are the two Olive Trees and the two Lampstands standing before the Lord of the earth.
