November 12, 1817	Birth of Bahá'u'lláh
1823	Mirzá Buzurg's dream
October 1835	Marriage of Bahá'u'lláh to Navváb
1839	Passing of Mirzá Buzurg, Bahá'u'lláh is offered his position in the Persian King's Court
May 22, 1844	Declaration of the Báb
May 23, 1844	The birth of `Abdu'l-Bahá
1844	The Báb gives Mullá Husayn the task of delivering a scroll to Bahá'u'lláh in Tihrán
1846	The birth of Bahiyih Khánum
1848	The birth of Mirzá Mihdí
June–July 1848	The Conference of Badašht
1848	Bahá'u'lláh visits Fort Tabarsí Bahá'u'lláh is arrested and bastinadoed
July 9, 1850	Martyrdom of the Báb
1851	Bahá'u'lláh arrives in Karbalá via Baghdád on His Muslim pilgrimage
1852	The attempt to assassinate the Šáh
August 1852	Bahá'u'lláh is arrested then taken to the Black Pit
October 1852	God reveals Himself to Bahá'u'lláh in the Black Pit
December 1852	Bahá'u'lláh is released from the Black Pit
January 12, 1853	Bahá'u'lláh is exiled to Baghdád
April 8, 1853	Bahá'u'lláh and His family arrive in Baghdád
1853	Mirzá Yahyá joins Bahá'u'lláh in Baghdád
April 10, 1854	Bahá'u'lláh leaves for the mountains of Sulaymáníyyih
March 19, 1856	Bahá'u'lláh returns from Sulaymáníyyih
1856	Bahá'u'lláh reveals the <i>Seven Valleys</i>
1857	Bahá'u'lláh reveals the <i>Four Valleys</i>
1858	Bahá'u'lláh reveals the <i>Hidden Words</i>
1860	Mirzá Mihdí, the son of Bahá'u'lláh, joins his family in Baghdád
1862	Bahá'u'lláh reveals the <i>Kitáb-i-Iqán</i>

 Marriage of `Abdu'l-Bahá to Munírih Khánum
 Bahá'u'lláh acquires the house of `Abbúd

 First visit of Bahá'u'lláh to the Riqvân Garden outside `Akká
 Bahá'u'lláh moves to the mansion of Bahjí
 The death of Navváb
